Contraindications	Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets are contraindicated in patients with a history of myocardial infarction, stroke, or other cardiovascular disease, or with a history of seizures. Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets are also contraindicated in patients with a history of bone marrow suppression or agranulocytosis.
Precautions	Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets should be used with caution in patients with a history of liver disease, kidney disease, or other conditions that may affect the metabolism or excretion of Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets. Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets should also be used with caution in patients who are taking other medications that may interact with Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets.
Adverse Reactions	The most common adverse reactions associated with Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets include drowsiness, dizziness, and constipation. Other adverse reactions may include changes in white blood cell counts, changes in liver function tests, and changes in kidney function tests.
Drug Interactions	Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets may interact with other medications, including antidepressants, antipsychotics, and sedatives. Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets may also interact with grapefruit juice and alcohol.
Use in Specific Populations	Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets should be used with caution in pregnant women and nursing mothers. Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets should also be used with caution in elderly patients and patients with a history of alcohol abuse.
Overdosage	In the event of an overdose of Clozapine (Clozaril) Tablets, the patient should be monitored closely for signs and symptoms of toxicity, including drowsiness, dizziness, and changes in heart rate and blood pressure.
